Re: Camp Dress Code

Greetings!

Although we dress in a relaxed fashion for camp, we want to look modest in our appearance. Camp Thunderbird's dress code is as follows:

All: Avoid any clothing containing suggestive pictures/wording, promoting alcohol, tobacco, and/or drug use. No jewelry. We are not responsible for lost or stolen jewelry, nor injuries caused by the wearing of jewelry. Acceptable "jewelry" is watches (not expensive) and medic alert bracelets. All shorts/skirts/skorts should come no less than 2 inches above the knee. No form-fitting attire.

Young Men: Pants will be worn at the waist. Males are to wear shirts at all times, except when involved in water activities. No tank tops. Must wear swimming trunks/shorts. NO speedos!

Young Ladies: Skirts and dresses should allow full stride, **without** splits. Swim suits should be **modest**, one-piece **only**, not exposing much of the torso or buttocks. Avoid sleeveless (or very short-sleeved) tops, revealing necklines, shorts tops exposing midriffs or skin at the waistline, and sheer or form-fitting attire. Also avoid cosmetics, nail polish, or gaudy hair decorations.
